

FIRE SAFETY



Tips to follow if you discover a fire in a building :



If you suspect fire in the building, test doors before opening. Use the back of your hand to feel the door or doorknob. If it is hot, use another escape route.

If you hear a fire alarm, call 101 to report the alarm, evacuate.



Know the location of fire extinguishers in your area and how to use them.

During evacuation, walk, don't run. Keep noise to a minimum.



Alert the occupants verbally and by pulling the emergency alarms, and evacuate the building.

Exit via stairway, and DO NOT USE ELEVATORS.



Once outside, move to an open area at least 150 feet away from the affected building(s). AVOID INNER COURTYARDS.

Keep roadways and walkways clear for emergency vehicles.



Be prepared. Know the location of the two exits closest to your area and all potential evacuation routes out of the building.

Never prop open hallway doors, or lock fire exit doors.
