MAKING YOUR CHILD SAFETY & SECURITY CONSCIOUS



Lay out some key ground rules like **never accepting offers of candy or rides from strangers**, or to get away from someone who is talking or acting in ways that make them feel uncomfortable.

Instruct your child to **never share their personal information** such as their name, address, phone number, or school information over social media. Educate them about what can happen if the wrong person gets their information.



When you go to a crowded place, take a moment to point out a location where everyone will go to meet if someone gets separated or they should **look for someone wearing a security or police uniform** for help.

Additionally, **build their self-esteem by communicating** with them regularly and answering their questions, no matter the topic.



Before you leave your children anywhere, **make sure they are in the hands of a reliable caretaker.**
